Day 1 – Tuesday, Sept. 8– Overnight flight Air Canada Toronto-Dublin

For those who purchased the Collins Tours All-Inclusive Air Package, make your way to your local airport for your assigned flight connecting your Air Canada flight to Dublin via Toronto's Pearson International Airport. **NOTE: 1st checked piece of luggage is free for international flights (up to maximum of 50lbs). 2nd bag is additional based on weight and size. Additional fees apply for overweight bags. Carry-on luggage is free, with a maximum weight of 22lbs per bag. Visit www.aircanada.com for more details on luggage fees. Any additional luggage payment is paid directly to Air Canada and not included in tour package. Fees are charged on both outbound & return flights.**

Day 2 – Wednesday, Sept. 9– Arrive in Dublin, Temple Bar Hotel (Welcome Reception)

- Upon arrival in Dublin this morning, each passenger will proceed through Irish Customs & Immigration and then to the luggage area to collect your luggage. Your Tour Manager will meet in the baggage claim area after you collect your own luggage. We make our way to our deluxe motorcoach, have all luggage loaded and make our way to our first city centre hotel together, the 4-star Temple Bar Hotel in Dublin City Centre.
- Please note: While an early check-in request has been made, hotel rooms are not guaranteed until 3:00p.m. Fashionable areas of Dublin such as Grafton Street and Jervis Street Shopping Centre are conveniently located within easy walking distance of our boutique Dublin city hotel as well as the Temple Bar & Jameson Distillery. There is an onsite restaurant (your expense), bar and a lobby café as well providing you with plenty of options before the room check-in time, or perhaps enjoy a pint of Guinness at one of the 666 licensed pubs in Dublin. Dublin produces an astonishing 10 million pints of Guinness... daily!
- Relax while your Tour Manager checks in all guests and distributes room keys when available.
- Take time to freshen up before our "Welcome Reception" inside our hotel including a glass of wine or beer and light appetizers - a chance to meet your fellow traveling companions (**included**).
- Following our reception, the remainder of the evening and dinner is at your leisure in fantastic and magical Dublin, Ireland. Sláinte!

Day 3 – Thursday, Sept 10.– Temple Bar Hotel, Dublin (B, Welcome D)

- After some well-deserved rest wake up to a delightful Irish buffet breakfast served at the hotel (**included**).
- Today we will meet our step-on guide for a 4-hour tour of one of the best cities in Europe. Tour local attractions such as the St. Patrick's Cathedral, Temple Bar area and other local sights plus a self-guided tour of the Guinness Brewery Storehouse!
- Enjoy lunch at the Guinness Brewery Storehouse (on own).
- Explore the city this afternoon at your leisure.
- You will have time to freshen up before meeting the group for our "Welcome Dinner" including live music with a traditional Irish dance show! (**Included**). Meet your fellow travelers and Tour Manager in the hotel's lobby for a short walk to the restaurant. We will have an Irish toast, "**May you have warm words on a cold evening, a full moon on a dark night, and a smooth road all the way to your door**" to the begin a great tour with new friends.



Day 4 – Friday, Sept. 11 – Dublin – Killarney Plaza Hotel and Spa, Killarney (B)

- An Irish buffet breakfast is included this morning at your hotel. Please have your tagged luggage outside of your room ready for pick up this morning as we check out and travel into the countryside.
- Board your motorcoach as we make our way today to Blarney Castle, built over 600 years ago. Blarney Castle was built by one of Ireland's greatest Chieftains, Cormac McCarthy, and has become one of Ireland's greatest treasures. Kiss the famed Blarney Stone (depending on wait times) which is known for its gifts of eloquence. You'll never again be lost for words! We have allotted a 2 ½ hour visit at the Castle including time for lunch (your expense). Then travel to Killarney, in County Kerry.
- Our hotel for the next two nights is the luxurious 4-star Killarney Plaza Hotel and Spa. The hotel is located on the doorstep of Ireland's oldest National Park and it blends classic luxury with a vibrant town centre. Relax as your bags are taken to your room for you (**included**) and your Tour Manager distributes your room keys.
- Tonight, enjoy this beautiful hotel with dinner on your own in one of the dining rooms, the formal Lake Room Restaurant or the more casual Height Lounge & Piano Bar.

Day 5 – Saturday, Sept. 12- Killarney- Ring of Kerry-Killarney (B, D) Optional Excursion – Traditional Jaunting Car Ride

- Wake up and enjoy another delightful Irish breakfast (**included**) at our hotel. Today's highlight is travelling around the Ring of Kerry. Our local guide will meet us for an all-day tour. The amazing scenery will take us past Killorglin and onto Glenbeigh. We make our way along the cliff roads that offer amazing panoramic views of the Dingle Peninsula and Dingle Bay. The Dingle Peninsula stretches 48 kilometers into the Atlantic Ocean. Take in this breathtaking scenery!
- Lunch today (on own) at a location along our route.
- Today, you have the option of experiencing a ride on a traditional jaunting car – powered by horse – set in tradition, now found only along the western coast of Ireland.
- Take time to relax before a group dinner with glass of wine or beer (**included**) at our hotel's restaurant.



Day 6 – Sunday, Sept. 13 – Killarney – Harbour Hotel, Galway (B, D)

- Time for another Irish breakfast (**included**). Be sure to cover any personal incidental hotel charges (ie movie rental, phone calls) before leaving the hotel.
- Meet your Tour Manager and board the motor coach as we make our way to Bunratty Castle (**entrance included**). Built in 1425, it is the most complete and authentic medieval castle in Ireland. The Castle was restored in 1954 and now contains mostly 15th and 16th century furnishings.
- During your visit you have time for lunch (on own) before we depart and make our way to Galway. Enjoy a scenic drive to Ireland's iconic Cliffs of Moher (**entrance and visit included**) before continuing to our hotel in Galway's city centre, the luxurious Harbour Hotel!
- Once again, your Tour Manager will check you into the hotel, distribute room keys and have your luggage sent to your room – all part of the Signature Collins Tours service.
- Enjoy a short walk to a nearby restaurant for another group dinner this evening (**included**).
- Following dinner, the remainder of the evening is on your own and at your expense.

Day 7 – Monday, Sept. 14 – Galway – Markree Castle, Sligo Bay (B, D)

- Another delightful Irish breakfast awaits you this morning. We will check out of the hotel this morning, meet the group and travel by motor coach to enjoy a river cruise.
- Today's highlight is the Corrib River Cruise. Sit back and enjoy this sailing complete with an authentic Irish Dancing demonstration and some world-famous Irish coffee (**admission & Irish coffee included**). Sip your coffee as we make our way past historical sites, castles, and local landmarks.
- We will have a lunch break following the Corrib River Cruise (on own).
- We will then board the coach and make our way to today's destination in Sligo Bay, Markree Castle! We will arrive late in the afternoon giving each of you time to enjoy this beautiful castle before our group dinner this evening!
- Take time to enjoy your overnight stay at Markree Castle, a truly unique property with old-world charm. This authentically restored Castle was originally built in the 14th century and provides delightful Irish hospitality.
- Luggage will be delivered to your room and your Tour Manager will again handle the group check-in process.
- Join the group this evening for dinner (**included**) inside the Markree Castle Hotel.

Day 8 – Tuesday, Sept. 15 – Markree Castle, Sligo Bay–Giant's Causeway–Fitzwilliam Hotel, Belfast (B)

- Following another Irish breakfast, we board our coach and make our way to Northern Ireland to Derry City (Londonderry).
- Enjoy this historic city with time for lunch (on own) before our walking tour begins at noon.
- We will enjoy a guided walking tour of Ireland's only completely intact walled city and the second largest city in Northern Ireland this afternoon.
- Next, we travel to the Giant's Causeway, the coastal geological phenomenon that was formed over 60 million years ago! (**Entrance fee included**). This incredible landmark is one of Northern Ireland's most visited sites, and for good reason! You can almost see why characters of Irish folklore were conjured by this beautiful and unique seaside setting.



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- Board the motor coach as we head to Belfast, the birthplace of the RMS Titanic. Belfast is the capital and largest city in Northern Ireland. Our home tonight is the 5-star luxury resort, The Fitzwilliam Hotel located in the heart of the city center.
- This evening dinner is on your own with many choices within walking distance of your hotel. The remainder of the evening to be enjoyed at your leisure. Perhaps you would like to visit “The Glass Jar” the Narrowest Bar in Belfast or wander the streets of this beautiful, modern city.

Day 9 – Wednesday, Sept. 16 – Belfast – Fitzpatrick Castle, Killiney Co. (B, Farewell D)

- Wake up and enjoy another Irish breakfast (**included**) before checking out.
- Join your Tour Manager, fellow passengers, and local guide for a 2-hour city tour of Belfast. We will learn about The Troubles and visit some of Belfast’s main districts, including the city centre, Cathedral Quarter and Titanic Quarter as we admire the city’s beautiful architecture. Following the tour, we will visit a local pub for a pint of Guinness! (**Price TBA**).
- We will stop for lunch, (on own) on our way to Killiney.
- Next, we drive south with rest stops along our route before we arrive at the beautiful Fitzpatrick Castle in Killiney, located just southeast of Dublin.
- Allow your Tour Manager to check you in and have luggage sent to your rooms one last time.
- Join your tour manager and fellow passengers for our “Farewell Dinner” with a glass of wine or beer (**included**). It is your opportunity to share stories with your new friends and begin to plan your next adventure with Collins Tours! ***Note: For a smooth departure tomorrow morning, your Tour Manager will arrange your flight check-in for everyone who has reserved the group airfare package with Collins Tours.***
- The rest of the evening can be enjoyed at your own leisure.



Day 10 – Thursday, Sept. 17 – Dublin to Canada (B)

- After a final Irish buffet breakfast, we bid farewell to Ireland. Airport transfers are included (time provided by your Tour Manager) for those who purchased Collins Tours’ All-Inclusive Air Package.
- Your Air Canada flight will travel to Toronto onward to your local airport, reaching the Maritimes all in the same day.

- **Baggage allowance details:** For all Air Canada flights to and from Europe: You are allowed one personal and one carry on item at no charge (max dimension: 23 cm x 40 cm x 55 cm). You are also allowed one free checked bag (max weight 23 kg; \$100 fee for overweight bag). Second checked bag is \$100 CAD each way.
- Currency used in the Republic of Ireland is the **Euro** and the **British Pound Sterling** is used in Northern Ireland. Duty
