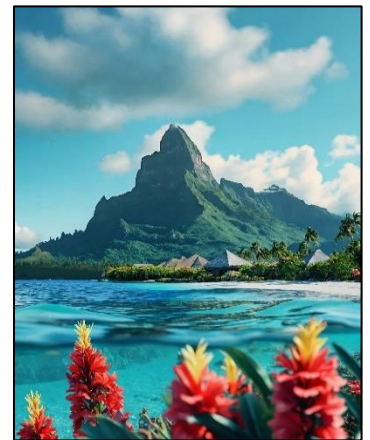

Day 15: Monday, Nov 16 – Moorea, French Polynesia (B, L, Group D)

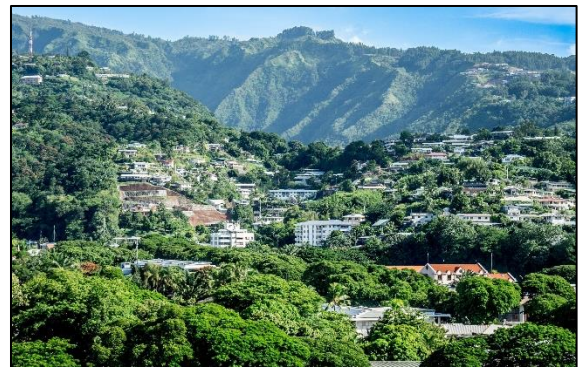
- Moorea, French Polynesia (7:00am – 5:00pm)
