Day 1 - Sunday, Mar 14 – Flight: Canada to Honolulu, Oahu, Hawaii

- Meet your tour manager at Toronto International Airport. All group flights are from local departure cities to Toronto with direct service to Honolulu. **Please NOTE: all passengers have their 1st checked piece of luggage (up to maximum of 50lbs) included in your tour package. Additional fees apply for overweight bags. Carry-on luggage is free, with a maximum weight of 22lbs per bag. Visit www.aircanada.com for more details on luggage fees. Luggage payments are paid directly to Air Canada for overweight or additional checked luggage. Fees are charged on both outbound & return flights.**
- Once you have arrived in Toronto, be sure to have your ***valid passport** for U.S. Customs & Immigration.
- Once in Honolulu, collect your individual luggage from the carousel and meet your tour manager who will direct us to our local representative and have the luggage loaded on our coach (bag handling fee included).
- Board the coach for your complimentary transfer to our hotel, the 5-star Waikiki Beach Marriott Resort & Spa.
- Enjoy your drive into Waikiki - one of the most famous beach areas in the world! Our hotel is located on Waikiki Beach and was fully renovated in 2020, totaling 120 million! Enjoy all that the Waikiki Beach Marriott Resort & Spa has to offer.

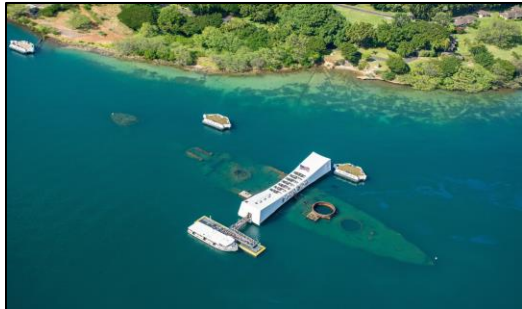
Day 2 – Monday, Mar 15 – Guided Sightseeing Tour – Historic Honolulu and Diamond Head Crater (B, Welcome Reception)

- Enjoy your included buffet breakfast this morning.
- Meet the coach this morning for our informative professionally guided tour, with local guide, of Honolulu. This tour will offer a great introduction to Oahu’s history, landscapes, and everyday life. Travel through the city and surrounding areas, including Honolulu’s historic district where you’ll enjoy unobstructed views of Iolani Palace, the State Capitol, and the King Kamehameha Statue. The tour will also feature stops at the Kapolei Lookout for panoramic views, the iconic Diamond Head Crater, and the National Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific at Punchbowl. Along the way, your local guide will share insight into Hawaii’s history, culture, and the significance of the sites you visit, with additional scenic and cultural points of interest included along the tour.

- You will have time for a light lunch or snack (not included) before returning to our hotel.

the island's unique bird, insect, and plant species, along with insights from leading volcanologists. Here, enjoy spectacular views from a scenic overlook high above a 400-foot crater, looking down into the 1959 vent beneath the Pu'u Pua'i cinder cone. Experience the island's raw volcanic power as you explore lava fields and stand near the Kilauea steam vents, where natural heat rises from the earth. Time permitting, the excursion concludes with a stop at Richardson's Black Sand Beach in Hilo, home to ancient Hawaiian fishponds and striking views toward Mauna Kea before returning to our hotel. **(Price TBA)**.

Lockers are available on site for an extra cost (locker expenses are not included in tour price). This is the most popular attraction in Hawaii and tickets are in high demand.
- **Duty Free Rules:** Each person can claim \$800 CAD if outside the country for 7 days or more.
- To simplify your shopping experiences, purchase American currency in advance, as many U.S. banks will not exchange your money without a U.S. bank account and passport in hand. Debit cards must be VISA or MasterCard flagged to be accepted at U.S. stores.
- Please remember that Collins Tours is not responsible for the loss of any personal items.
