### Day 1 – Sunday, Sept 25 – Overnight flight to Zurich, Switzerland

- For those who have purchased Collins Tours' All-Inclusive Air package, you will depart from your local airport and meet the Tour Manager along your route for your group flight to Zurich. **PLEASE NOTE: Each passenger has 1 piece of luggage included up to 50 lbs each bag, included in the Collins Tours Inclusive Airfare Package. Additional pieces of luggage may require fees paid directly to the airline. Fees will be charged on both the outbound and return flights if applicable.** Be sure to have your **\*valid passport of at least 3 months from your last day in Europe.**

### Day 2 – Monday, Sept 26 – Zurich to Lucerne, Switzerland – Astoria Hotel – Welcome Reception \*\*Optional Excursion (see website for current details)

- Arrive in Zurich, Switzerland! Your tour director will meet you at the baggage claim area **(do not leave baggage claim area without your tour manager)**. After clearing customs, we board our private motorcoach to Mt. Pilatus where you will take a gondola ride. Enjoy the incredible view of Lake Lucerne and the surrounding Alps, followed by the cog railway trolley before returning to the bus and heading to the Astoria Hotel, our home for the next two nights. **(included optional excursion for early bookings made by Jan 14<sup>th</sup>, 2026, only – following Jan 14<sup>th</sup>, this excursion will be an additional \$165 CAD per person).**
- Check in at our hotel today is not until 4:00 pm and although we have requested an early check-in, rooms may not be ready upon arrival. If your room is not ready, take some time to explore your surrounding areas on your own (your expense).
- Once rooms are ready, your tour manager will handle the group check in, distribute your room keys and have your luggage delivered to your rooms – all a part of your Collins Tours Signature check in process you will experience throughout your tour.



- This evening, join your tour manager and fellow travellers for a 1-hour, “Welcome to the Alps” cocktail reception with wine & and light appetizers **(included)**. Here you will have an opportunity to meet your fellow travellers and discuss the exciting tour ahead.
- Following our cocktail reception, feel free to enjoy the city and dinner at your leisure (your expense).

### Day 3 – Tuesday, Sept 27 – Lucerne, Switzerland (B, Welcome D)

- Wake up and enjoy a delicious Swiss breakfast buffet this morning **(included)**.
- After breakfast, meet your tour manager and professional local guide for a 2-hour guided walking tour of Lucerne **(included - walking in old town lucerne requires comfortable footwear with support and coaches are not permitted inside the old town)**. After the tour, enjoy lunch on your own in one of the many cafes with free time in the afternoon. Transportation will be provided back to the hotel at a designated time, so that you have a chance to freshen up before our group dinner!
- This evening, please meet your tour manager and join your fellow Collins Tours group passengers for a Welcome Group Dinner at a fabulous restaurant, just a short walk from our hotel. Tonight, you will sample some delectable local cuisine with a glass of wine or beer included with your meal **(included)**. We will share stories together and discuss further details of our amazing experience that has just begun!
- Following dinner, the remainder of the evening is at your leisure (your expense).

### Day 4 – Wednesday, Sept 28 – Lucerne – Grand Hotel Des Iles de Borromees & Spa, Stresa, Italy (B, Welcome Reception)

- After another delicious Swiss Buffet breakfast this morning, get ready for an exciting journey driving through the Alps. Travel by premium motor coach to Locarno which is a small, picturesque town on the border of Switzerland and Italy. Enjoy lunch (on own) and some time for shopping before arriving in Stresa. Our hotel, located in Stresa is called the Grand Hotel des Iles Borromées & Spa, a beautiful 5-star hotel across the mountainous border from Switzerland to the Lake District of Italy, on Lake Maggiore!
- We expect to arrive at the hotel late this afternoon. Once again, your tour manager will handle check-in for your group, distribute your rooms keys, and have your luggage delivered to your room. Please note passports are required to be photocopied upon check in. This is part of Italy’s regulation process.
- After check-in, join your fellow passengers for a Welcome Reception with dry snacks.
- The rest of the evening is free for you to explore this picturesque area of Italy’s Lake District (your expense). Excellent shops and restaurants are located within walking distance.



### Day 5 – Thursday, Sept 29 – Stresa, Italy (B, Authentic Italian Group D)

- Wake up this morning and enjoy a delightful Italian buffet breakfast.
- Today’s highlight is our boat cruise on Lake Maggiore with a professional local guide. We will visit Isola Bella islands and offer fantastic views of mountainous backdrops over Italian lakeside villages, and visit the Borromeo Palace (ticket included) on the island which is now a museum during most the year.
- Tonight, we head to a nearby restaurant for a beautiful authentic Italian 4-course dinner with wine and music **included!**
- After dinner, you will have plenty of time to relax or explore this beautiful lakeside town (your expense).

### Day 6 – Friday, Sep 30 – Stresa – Montecatini Palace, (Tuscany) Italy (B, Group D)

- After our final breakfast by the lake **(included)**, we will board our private motor coach and head south to our next destination, the stunning hills of Tuscany! There will be rest stops along the way as we make our way to the heart of Tuscany.

- Today, we will visit one of the region’s renowned Tuscan vineyards, where we’ll enjoy a guided tour and a wine tasting experience **(Included)**.
- Capture the refined elegance of one of Italy’s most celebrated spa towns. Surrounded by graceful boulevards and historic thermal baths, the hotel reflects the area’s long-standing tradition of wellness and leisure that has drawn visitors since the 19th century. Its sleek, contemporary design is softened by touches of classic Italian sophistication, creating an atmosphere that feels both modern and timeless. With its rooftop views over the Tuscan hills, tranquil spa spaces, and proximity to the town’s famed thermal heritage, the hotel offers a serene retreat where relaxation, culture, and understated luxury come together.
- Once again, your Tour Manager will handle check-in for your group, distribute your room keys, and have your luggage delivered to your room! Please note passports are required to be photocopied upon check in. This is part of Italy’s regulation process.
- Take some time to freshen up before gathering together for another wonderful Tuscan Group Dinner **(included)**
- Following dinner, the rest of the evening is free for you to explore (your expense).



## Day 7- Saturday, Oct 1 - Tuscany – Splendid Venice Hotel, Italy (B, Cocktail Reception)

- Enjoy another Italian buffet breakfast in this stunningly picturesque setting before we depart and make our way to Venice.
- Venice is the capital of northern Italy’s Veneto region. It is built on more than 100 small islands in a lagoon in the Adriatic Sea. It has no roads, just canals – including the Grand Canal thoroughfare – lined with Renaissance and Gothic palaces. The central square, Piazza San Marco contains St. Mark’s Basilica, which is tiled with Byzantine mosaics, and the Campanile bell tower offering views of the city’s red roofs.
- Tonight’s hotel is on Venice’s main island, and we will arrive by water taxi, approximately 30 minutes from our departure at Tronchetto station. Please note, your luggage will be taken from the pier side into the water taxi, and then into your hotel - all part of your package. Soak in the sea breeze and feast your eyes on one of the world’s truly unique and breathtaking cities.
- We expect a late afternoon check-in to the 5-star Splendid Venice Hotel complete with a roof top patio and bar. Enjoy some time to freshen up for your first evening in the stunning “City of Water”.
- Join us for a Private Rooftop, cocktail reception at the hotel **(included)**. Hot & cold appetizers and wine or beer are included, as we enjoy this beautiful hotel, just 3 min walk to St. Marks Square and all the fabulous Italian Shops!
- After the reception, you are free to enjoy dinner and the remainder of the evening as you please. Perhaps a romantic gondola ride is of interest to you or you may want to try an authentic Italian restaurant just steps away from your hotel.



## Day 8 – Sunday, Oct 2 – Venice, Italy (B)

- Enjoy a delightful Venetian buffet breakfast today.
- Following breakfast we will depart on our professionally guided sightseeing tour of Venice **(included)**! Your tour will include walking where 117 islands are connected by a latticework of 150 canals and 400 bridges. Highlights include a visit to St. Mark’s Square where our local expert takes you on a tour of the Basilica, Doge’s Palace, and legendary Bridge of Sighs.
- Our tour guide departs and leaves us for lunch (on own) in any of the many restaurants around St. Mark’s Square or adjacent streets. (Please note restaurants located within the square are more expensive than

ones located a 5 or 10 min walk away from the square). You will then have time on your own to enjoy some shopping and people watching this afternoon.

- Your evening and dinner are free to enjoy as you wish in this truly spectacular city (your expense)! Enjoy your last evening in Venice!

## Day 9 – Monday, Oct 3 – Venice, Italy – Amadria Park Royal, Opatjia, Croatia (B, D)

- Enjoy your final Venetian buffet breakfast before we check-out of our hotel. Enjoy your water taxi transfer back to Tronchetto terminal, before loading our private motor coach that will take us to our next neighbouring country, Croatia.
- Seaside city of Opatjia is perfectly situated as a midpoint along our route. Reopened to the “western world” in the 1990’s, Croatia has quickly become a top destination for international visitors with its crystal-clear waters along the Adriatic Sea and hundreds of islands dotting its shoreline.
- Upon arrival in Opatjia, your tour manager will handle check-in, distribute your room keys and your luggage sent to your rooms. Our home for the night is the 4-star Amadria Park Royal Hotel with access to the nearby Royal Beach and has a front entrance to the vibrant main street. It combines two Austro-Hungarian villas with a Mediterranean garden-style restaurant, features floral motifs and decorative antique touches throughout with plenty of things to enjoy.
- This evening, meet your tour manager and fellow friends for another group dinner (**included**).
- Following dinner, the rest of the evening are yours to explore on your own (your expense) .

## Day 10 – Tuesday, Oct 4 – Opatjia to Radisson Blu Resort & Spa, Split, Croatia (B, D)

- Rise and shine in beautiful Opatjia. Enjoy an **included** breakfast this morning before checkout and our drive to Plitviče National Park.
- You will be given time for lunch (**at your expense**) before we make our way into the park on a guided tour. This series of stunning waterfalls are sure to take your breath away. Have your camera ready for some incredible photo opportunities. **Please note there is walking involved today and for those who wish to explore the area you will need to be able to walk on own without assistance.**
- After our guided tour of the National Park, we make our way to Split Croatia – our home for the night. Tonight, we will arrive at the 5 Star Radisson Blu Resort and Spa.
- Enjoy a delicious group dinner tonight with a glass of wine or beer with your fellow travelers. (**Group Dinner included**).



## Day 11 – Wednesday, Oct 5 – Split, Croatia (B)

- After breakfast, (**Included**) meet your fellow passengers in the lobby for a quick drive into Split’s Old Town where we will welcome a local professional guide to walk us through the historic center of the city. Marvel at the wonderfully preserved remains of Diocletian’s monumental palace while navigating the narrow and winding lanes within its walls.
- After our tour, grab some lunch (**at your expense**) and spend the rest of the afternoon on your own. Perhaps you might want to take this opportunity to do some shopping for local trinkets.
- Board the motor coach for transfer to our hotel to watch the sun sink below the surface of the Adriatic.
- Dinner and the remainder of the evening will be on your own (your expense).



## Day 12 – Thursday, Oct 6 – Split to Hotel Royal Neptun, Dubrovnik, Croatia (B)

- Enjoy an included breakfast at your hotel this morning.
- Today we drive south after breakfast and checking out of our hotel towards Dubrovnik, Croatia! Dubrovnik is known for its stunning beauty, scenic landscapes, rich history and culture and picturesque architecture. Often called the “Pearl of the Adriatic”, Dubrovnik is famous for its incredibly well-preserved old town which is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- You will have time to have lunch (on own) in Dubrovnik, before choosing to join us on an optional excursion.
- Join us today for an optional 4.5-hour tour of Dubrovnik (Price TBA). Today’s excursion includes a knowledgeable local guide taking us on a walking tour of the old city before our private coach whisks us out to the Croatian countryside. After taking in panoramic views of this beautiful port, we stop at a local winery to enjoy a tasting of local wine and charcuterie (included in tour cost). This is sure to be a highlight of Dubrovnik!
- Dinner and the remainder of the evening are on your own (your expense).



## Day 13 – Friday, Oct 7 – Dubrovnik, Croatia (B, Farewell Group D)

- Enjoy breakfast today before checking out of the hotel.
- Meet your professional local guide this morning for a morning hour tour of the fortified old town. Learn the city’s origins and development through the years before touching on the sad and tragic stories of the Croatian War of Independence in the 1990s. Take a short walk along the walls and admire stunning views of the Adriatic coastline.
- Lunch and time spent this afternoon is at your leisure and your expense.
- Tonight, we gather for our Farewell Group Dinner (**Group Dinner included with wine or beer**). We will share our wonderful memories together, plan our next journey and plan for our return home to Canada.
- Following your group dinner, the remainder of the evening is on your own (your expense).

## Day 14 – Saturday, Oct 8 – Dubrovnik to Canada (B)

- Enjoy breakfast this morning before we meet our private motor coach and make our way to the airport for our return flight home.
- For those who have purchased Collins Tours Inclusive Air Package, please meet your tour manager for transfer to the airport. You will have an overnight stay in London and return home on October 9, 2027.
- If you’ve arranged airfare on your own, thank you for joining Collins Tours on this inspired adventure.

- Baggage allowance details: For all Air Canada flights to and from Canada: You are allowed one personal and one carry on item at no charge (max dimension 23 cm x 40 cm x 55 cm). You are also allowed one free checked bag (max weight 23 kg; \$100 fee for overweight bag each way). Airline fees for any checked baggage overages or additional bags (both outbound and inbound flights) are NOT included in your tour package, and any additional costs are your responsibility paid directly to Air Canada.
- Airline fees for any checked baggage overages or additional bags (both outbound and inbound flights) are **NOT** included in your tour package, and any additional costs are your responsibility paid directly to Air Canada.
- All liquids/gels you plan to bring on board an airplane must be 3oz or less and sealed in a Ziploc bag. Once at the security checkpoint, this bag must be removed from your carryon & placed in bin for TSA screening.
